1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. The petitioner in this application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short “Cr.P.C.”) has prayed for quashing of the further proceeding in I.C.C. No.4695 of 2009 pending in the court of the learned J.M.F.C., Bhubaneswar.
