04. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/ physical) mode.
2. During course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays for withdrawal of this bail application in respect of the Petitioner No.1. Accordingly, this application stands disposed of as withdrawn in respect of Petitioner No.1. The ABLAPL is now confined only to Petitioner No. 2, hereinafter referred to as 'the Petitioner'.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Considering the submissions and on going through the charge-sheet submitted and the nature of accusations; further keeping in view the surrounding circumstances of the case as also concerning the Petitioner and in the absence of any other impediment, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the Court in seisin of the case in Bhandaripokhari P.S. Case No.39 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. Case No.349 of 2020 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Bhandrak within three weeks hence and moves for his release on bail, he shall be released on bail

on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said Court with further condition that he will not threaten or terrorize the prosecution witnesses in any manner.

5. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
