1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. The decision of the Supreme Court in the cases of **Yogendra Kumar Jaiswal and others vs. State of Bihar and others** with **Ramendra alias Raman Dhuldhue vs. State of Madhya Pradesh** with **Balbhadra Parashar vs. State of Madhya Pradesh**, reported in **(2016) 3 SCC 183** and also in view of the amendment carried out in Section-18 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, the petitioner has noticed substantial change in the circumstances, which require him to amend the writ petition, instead he would press to withdraw the writ petition with liberty reserved to file a fresh petition.
