1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioners are stated to be the members of the family of the in-laws of the informant.
4. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 2133 of 2022, arising out Bhratpur P.S. Case No.126 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections-498(A)/341/294/323/506/34 of the I.P.C and read with Section-4 of the D.P. Act.
