2. Heard Mr. A.Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. D. Gochhayat, learned Central Government Counsel appearing for the Opposite Parties.

3. The Petitioner has filed this Writ Petition seeking to quash the order of demand Notice dated 13.04.2022 vide Annexure-3 and to issue direction to the Opposite Party No.2 to accept her withdrawal of license and adjust the period of Covid-19 in the said demand notice.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.2 vide Annexure-5 series and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned counsel for the Union of India has no objection.
