1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 242 of 2022, arising out of Nayagarh P.S. Case No. 47 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Nayagarh for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections- 379/411 of the I.P.C read with Section 12 of Minerals Prevention of theft Smuggling and Others Unlawful Activities Act.
4. Taking into account, the nature of allegation, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and

moving for bail, the petitioner shall be released on bail. The Learned Court in seisin over the matter to fix the terms and conditions as deemed just and proper.

While enlarging the petitioner on bail, the learned Court below shall verify such assertion.
