1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 179 of 2022, arising out of Khamar P.S. Case No. 81 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Pallahara for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections-498-A/323/324/506/34 of the I.P.C and read with Section-4 of the D.P. Act.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner places on record, one agreement between the parties by way of an affidavit by the

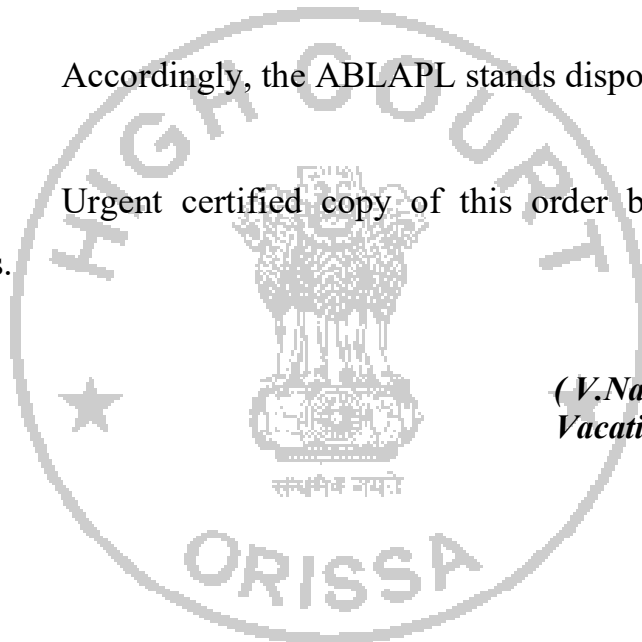
petitioner indicating that the matter has been amicably settled with the intervention of well-wishers.
