1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard Mr. A. Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner, Ms. S. Mishra, learned counsel for the State and Mr. B.K. Behera, learned counsel appearing for the informant.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 237 of 2022, arising out of Nayagarh P.S. Case No. 46 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Nayagarh for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections-493/420/294/506/34 of the I.P.C read with Section-4 of the D.P. Act.
