1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No. 199 of 2015, arising out of Choudwar P.S. Case No. 33 of 2015 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C. (R), Cuttack for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 419/420/294/506/34 of the I.P.C.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that this is a case of false implication, which is rebutted by the learned counsel for the State inasmuch as he submitted that in the meanwhile the Charge-sheet has already been filed on 16.09.2019 against the petitioners.

5. Taking into account the nature of the allegation and the Charge-sheet has already been filed, this Court directs that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the petitioners shall be released on bail. The learned Court in seisin over the matter to fix the terms and conditions as deemed just and proper.

6. It is submitted by the learned Counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have no criminal proclivity. While enlarging the petitioners on bail, the learned Court below shall verify such assertion. If it comes to the fore that the petitioners have any criminal antecedents, this order shall stand recalled automatically without any further reference to this Court.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.

8. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
