1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. 2. Heard learned counsel for both the Parties.
3. 3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“1. Directing the Opp.Party No.1 to extend the benefits of 2nd RACP with grade pay of Rs.6600/- instead of Rs.5400/-. Keeping in view the order of the learned Tribunal in O.A. No.1454/2019 under Annexure-5.

And further be pleased to direct the opposite parties to grant MACP as per the ORSP Rules 2017 w.e.f. 07.05.2018 as has been extended to similar circumstances person as per Annexure-10 series.

And further be pleased to direct the opposite parties to fix the pension of the petitioner after availing of MACP w.e.f. 07.05.2018.

And further be pleased to direct the opp.parties to disburse the arrear after modifying the office order towards 2nd RACP Grade Pay of Rs.6600/- instead of Rs.5400/-”.

4. He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation on 11.10.2021 at Annexure-9 to the Writ Petition, before the opposite party No.1 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law and also taking into account the order passed under Annexures-5 & 10-Series within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
