1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.185 of 2022 arising out of Rajnagar P.S. Case No.153 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Rajnagar for commission of offence punishable under Sections 363/294/323/354/427/379/506/34 of IPC.
4. It is stated at the bar that the petitioner is the father of the principal accused. Taking into account the age of the petitioner and the role ascribed to him, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the petitioner shall be
