1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No. 232 of 2022, arising out of Nilagiri P.S. Case No. 155 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Nilgiri for the alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections-341/294/323/325/307/506/34 of the I.P.C.

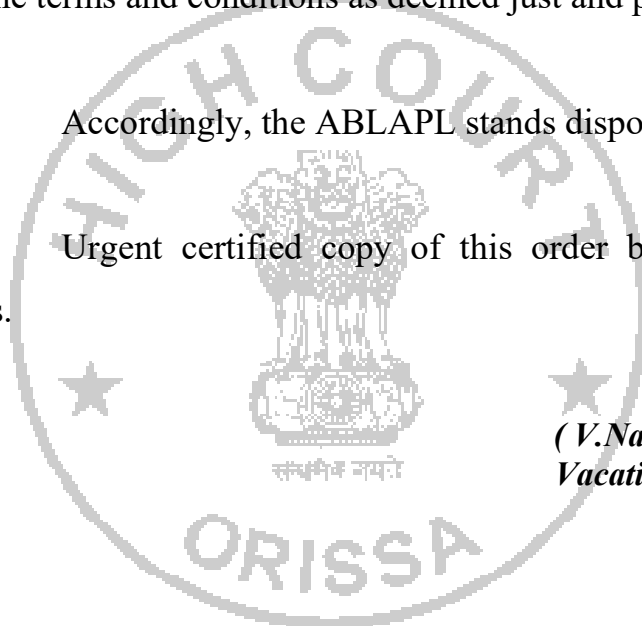
5. Copy of the Injury Report submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner be kept on record.
