1. Heard Mr. S.B. Mohanty, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. D.K. Mohanty, learned Additional Standing Counsel.
 2. According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is aggrieved by the tardy manner in which investigation is proceeding in connection with Nayapalli P.S. Case No.89 dated 15.02.2020 registered for commission of offences under Sections 498-A/313/323/325/506/34 of I.P.C. read with Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.
 3. During course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to move the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Bhubaneswar (opposite party No.2) for redressal of her grievances by filing a grievance petition and the said opposite party be directed to take a decision on such motion at an early date.
 4. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court

grants liberty to the petitioner to file a grievance petition before opposite party No.2 through registered post within a period of two weeks from today. In the event, such a petition is filed along with a copy of this order, the opposite party No.2 is directed to take a decision on the same in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of such grievance petition and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, this CRLMP is disposed of.

6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
