1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.323 of 2022, arising out of Abhayachandpur P.S. Case No.176 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge-cum-J.M.F.C., Erasama for commission of offence punishable under Sections 294/341/323/307/506 of IPC.
