1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.224 of 2022, arising out of Joda P.S. Case No.67 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Barbil for commission of offence punishable under Sections 147/ 148/ 149/ 186/ 294/ 307/ 323/ 341/ 353/ 506/ 120-B/153-A/295-A of the IPC read with Section 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 and Section 7 of Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1983.
4. Taking into account the nature of allegation, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the

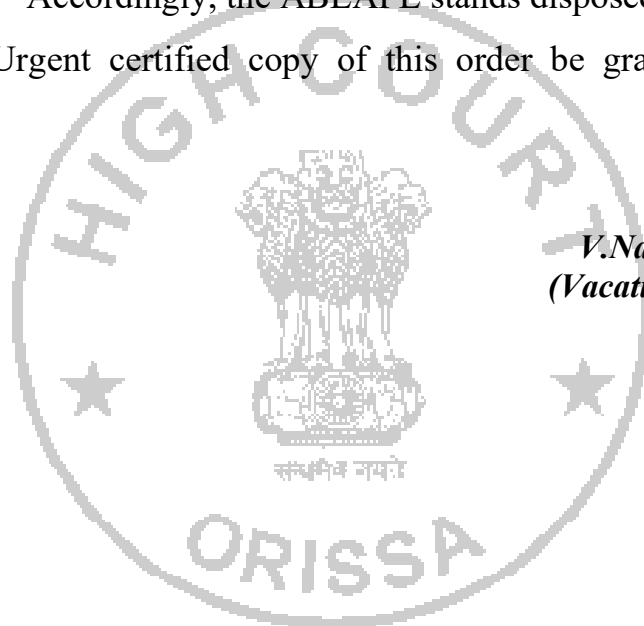
learned Court in seisin over the matter on such terms as deemed just and proper.
