1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical mode.)
2. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for both the parties and perused the records.
4. Considering the nature and gravity of offences alleged against the Petitioner, I am not inclined to release the Petitioner on bail. However, this Court directs that in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar in C.T. Case No.2747 of 2022, arising out of Nayapalli P.S. Case No.309 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper.
5. It is further directed that in the event of release of the Petitioner, he shall not indulge in any offences, tamper with the

evidence or threat to the prosecution witnesses and cooperate with the investigation.

6. This Court further observes that if the Petitioner is found to have indulged in similar type of offences, this order shall automatically stand revoked and the learned Magistrate shall issue NBW of arrest against the Petitioner.

7. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
