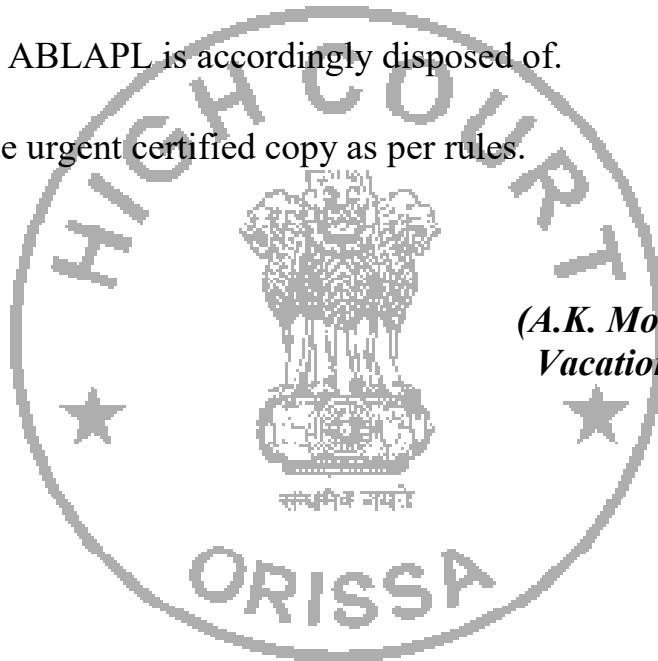
1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical mode.)
2. Heard learned counsel for both the parties and perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that Petitioner has no criminal antecedents of similar nature.
5. Considering the nature and gravity of offences alleged against the Petitioner, I am not inclined to release the Petitioner on bail. However, this Court directs that in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned N.G.N. Court, Ghasipura, in G.R. Case No.183 of 2022, arising out of Ramachandrapur P.S. Case No.92 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper.

6. It is further directed that in the event of release of the Petitioner, he shall not indulge in any offences, tamper with the evidence or threat to the prosecution witnesses and cooperate with the investigation. To that effect, he shall give an undertaking before the court below.

7. This Court further observes that if the Petitioner is found to have indulged in similar type of offences, this order shall automatically stand revoked and NBW of arrest shall be issued against the Petitioner.

8. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
