1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody in connection with Special Task Force, Bhubaneswar Case No. 7 of 2022 corresponding to T.R. Case NO. 91 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Khurda at Bhubaneswar for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 21(C)/29 of NDPS Act.
4. Considering the fact that the seized contraband is more than commercial quantity weighing 1320 grams of brown sugar, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail, which is, therefore rejected.
5. The BLAPL is accordingly rejected.
