1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

3. The petitioner in the writ petition prays for a direction to the opposite parties particularly opposite party No.2, Collector, Sundargarh who is the statutory authority to take action regarding grievances of the petitioner as Annexure-1 series .
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the authorities may be directed to consider his grievances and disposed of in accordance with law.
5. Learned AGA submits that the authority shall consider the grievances of the petitioner in accordance with law and dispose of the same in due time.

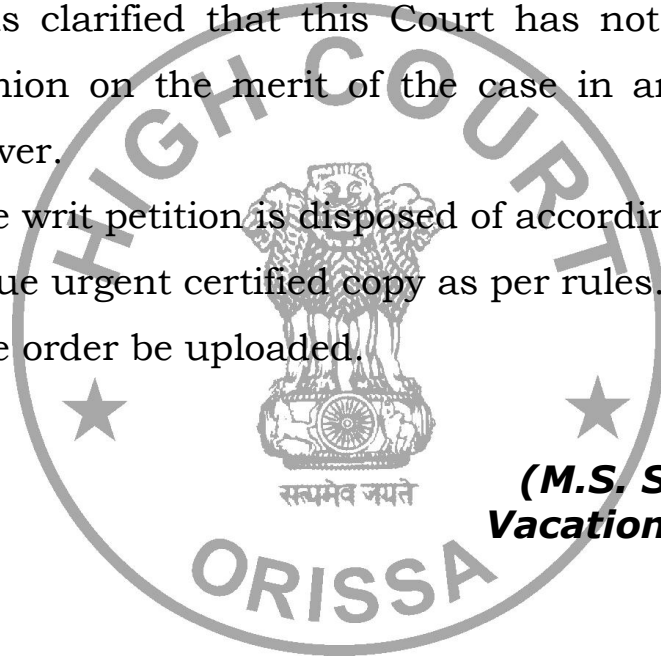
8. Opposite party No.5 shall be given adequate opportunity of hearing to present her case before the appropriate authority.
