1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:

“to direct the opp. parties more particularly to O.P. No.4, the ARCS, Nayagarh to ensure that the benefit of letter issued by Opp. Party No.2 as per Annexure-5 is made available to the petitioner forthwith w.e.f the date of its issue and the petitioner is paid with differential amount by O.P. No.5 & 6 respectively within a stipulated period, and further be pleased to pass such other order(s)/issue directions(s) or writ(s) as may be deemed just and proper in the bona fide interest of justice.”

4. He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation at Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.4 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.4 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
