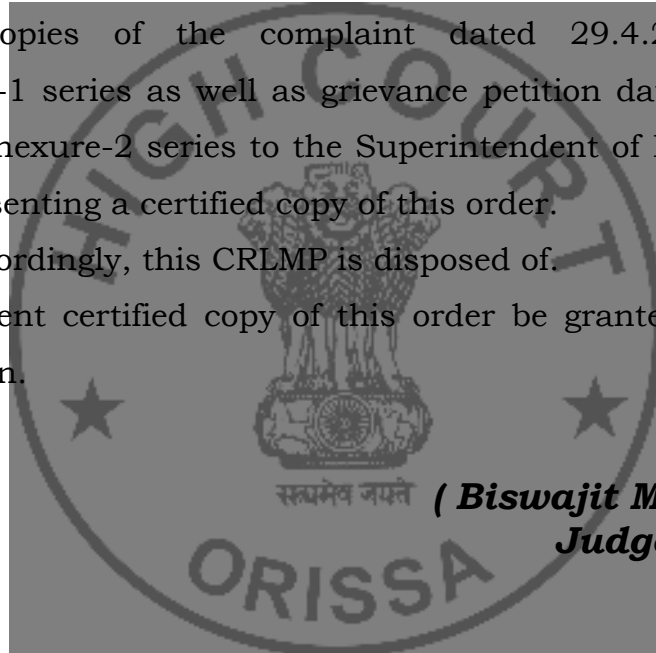
01. 1. Heard Mr.B.Tripathy, learned counsel on behalf of Mr.B.P.B.Bahali, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Nayak, learned Additional Government Advocate.
2. According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the grievance of the petitioner in this case pertains to non-registration of his complaint dated 29.4.2022 under Annexure-1 series as F.I.R. by the I.L.C., Angul Police Station (opposite party No.3) though the same reveals commission of cognizable offences. When nothing was done, the petitioner sent a copy of the complaint to the said opposite party through registered post on the same date. Further as there was no response from opposite party No.3, the petitioner sent a grievance petition dated 7.5.2022 to the Superintendent of Police, Angul (opposite party No.2) under Annexure-2 series through registered post on the same date, however till date no action has been taken on the same. In such background, he prays that necessary direction be given to the opposite party No.2 to take a decision on the said

grievance petition within a specific time period.

3. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the Superintendent of Police, Angul (opposite party No.2) to take a decision on the grievance petition dated 7.5.2022 of the petitioner under Annexure-2 series in accordance with law keeping in mind the decision of the Supreme Court in the case of **Lalita Kumari Vs. State of U.P. & Others** reported in **AIR 2014 SC 187** within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, if in the meantime, the same has not been disposed of and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to supply copies of the complaint dated 29.4.2022 under Annexure-1 series as well as grievance petition dated 7.5.2022 under Annexure-2 series to the Superintendent of Police, Angul while presenting a certified copy of this order.

4. Accordingly, this CRLMP is disposed of.

5. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
