1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
3. Being aggrieved by the Order dtd.09.11.2021 passed by the Learned J.M.F.C., Basudevpur in G.R. No. 1491 of 1995 issuing NBW against the petitioners for non-appearance on the date fixed. The present CRLMC has been filed under Section-482 Cr.P.C.
4. Considering the recitals in the CRLMC petition and submission of the learned counsel for the parties, this Court does not find any infirmity in the impugned order. Yet, to enable the learned counsel for the petitioners to effectively defend his rights,

this Court directs that on surrendering within a period of three weeks hence, the petitioners shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions to be fixed by the learned Court in seisin over the matter.

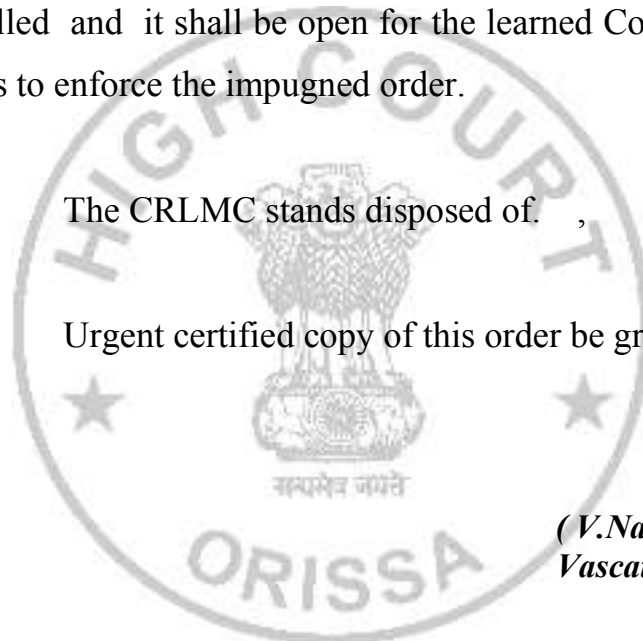
The impugned order is set aside.
