03. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the informant and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in connection with G.R. Case No.603 of 2022 arising out

of Khallikote P.S. Case No.262 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Khallikote for alleged commission of offences under sections 143/341/294/323/326/307/506/149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Perused the F.I.R.

Learned counsel for the State on verification of the case record submitted that the injured is one Iswar Gouda, who has sustained four injuries out of which three injuries have been opined to be simple in nature and one injury on the right forearm has been opined might be grievous in nature. She placed the statement of the eye witness Panchu Gouda from which it appears that the accused persons assaulted the injured by means of kick and fist blows.

Learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties, the nature of accusation against the petitioners, the nature of injury sustained by the injured and the background of the case, I am inclined to release the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, this Court directs that in the event of arrest of the petitioners in connection with the aforesaid case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer with further conditions that they shall make themselves

available for interrogation by the I.O. as and when required and they shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to the Investigating Officer.

Violation of any of the above conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
