The petitioner is an accused in Special (POCSO) Case No.23 of 2022, on the files of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Court under POCSO Act, Angul, arising out of Chhendipada P.S. Case No.133 of 2022, under Sections 452/354-A/354-B/380/506 of the IPC read with Section 12 & 18 of the POCSO Act subsequently turned into under Section 450/376/511/506 of the IPC read with Section 4(1), 18 and 8 of the POCSO act.
4. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned A.D.J.-cum-Special Court under

POCSO Act, Angul by order dated 19.05.2022 in the
aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.

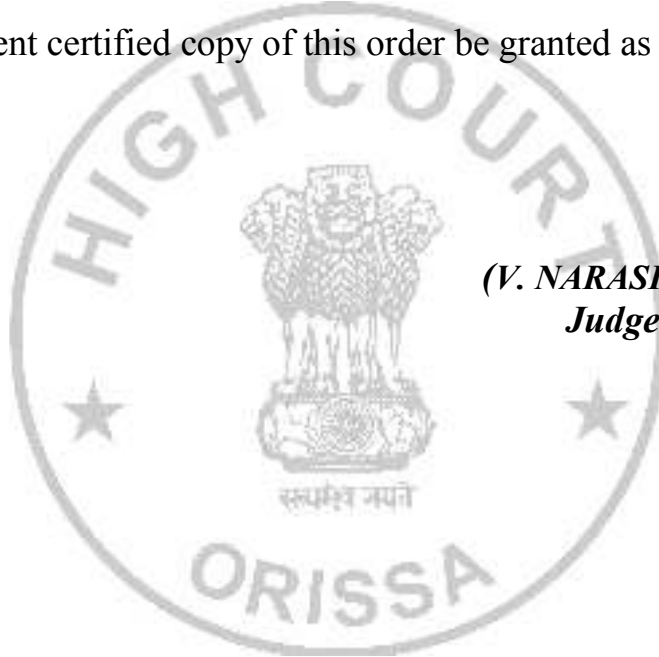
5. Learned counsel for the State submits that in the
