1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. This Contempt Petition is filed alleging violation of the Court's order dated 10.03.2022 passed in W.P.(C) No.6200 of 2022.

Considering the submission made and as a last opportunity this Court deems it proper to provide as a last chance and the Contempt Petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Opposite Party-Contemnor to comply with the direction of this Court dated 10.03.2022 passed in W.P.(C) No.6200 of 2022, if the same has not been complied with in the meantime, within a period of two months from the date of service of a certified copy of this order by the Petitioner, provided the operation of order/judgment has not been stayed by higher forum and file compliance report before the Registry of this Court within one week thereafter.
