1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition to prefer an appeal which is statutorily provided for in the Guidelines relating to Anganwadi Worker.
