2. Heard Mr. A. Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. P. K. Parhi, learned ASGI.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.2 to grant oil transportation order to the Petitioner in terms of letter of acceptance as at Annexure-2 forthwith and dispose of its representation under Annexure-3 Series.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before opposite party no.2-General Manager, Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. vide Annexure-3 Series, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time.
