This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner Ananta Kumar Patra with a prayer to cause production/rescue of his minor daughter.

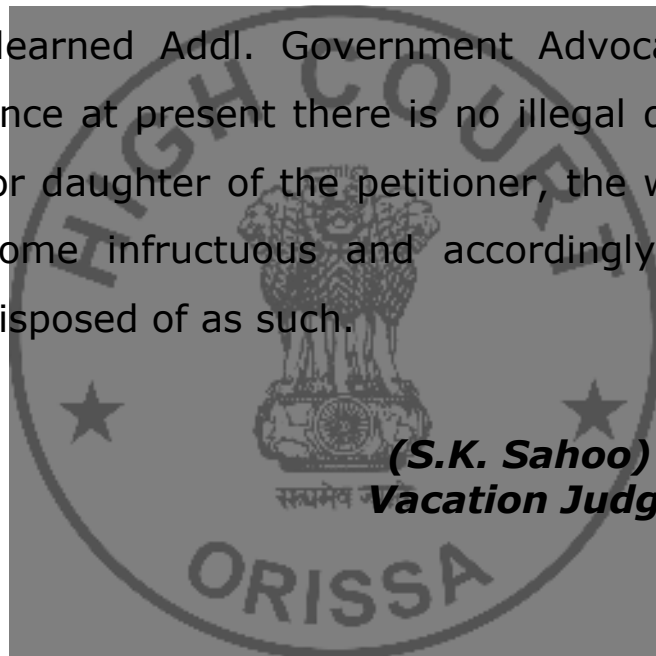

Government Advocate for the State, since at present there is no illegal detention of the minor daughter of the petitioner, the writ petition has become infructuous and accordingly the same stands disposed of as such.
