01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with G.R. Case No.233 of 2022 arising out of Paralakhemundi P.S. Case No.88 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Paralakhemundi for alleged commission of offences under sections 294/435/379/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with section 4 of the Public Property (Prevention of Damage) Act, 1985.

Perused the F.I.R.

Learned counsel for the State on instruction submitted that the petitioner has got three criminal antecedents.

In view of such criminal antecedents, while not inclining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, it is observed that in the event the petitioner surrenders and moves for bail in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be disposed of by the learned Courts below in accordance with law expeditiously. The case records shall be made available to the Court concerned for adjudication of the bail application.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
