1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody being remanded on 10.08.2021 in connection with Chandapur P.S. Case No.170 of 2018 corresponding to G.R. Case No.402 of 2018 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Ranapur for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 399/402 of IPC.
4. It is alleged that the petitioner along with some other persons were preparing to commit dacoity sitting in a vehicle while they were arrested by the police. It is stated that the petitioner has been entangled in this case on the basis of the statement of the co-accused and there is no specific allegation against the petitioner.
5. Considering the above facts, materials on record, period of detention in custody and the fact that charge sheet has been submitted, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as

the Court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall personally appear before the trial Court on each date of posting of the case without fail. Further he shall appear before the IIC of Chandapur Police Station once in every fortnight for a period of six months.

6. BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
