This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This is an application for modification of the order dated 13.07.2022.

After hearing the learned counsel for the respective parties and taking into account the grounds taken in the interim application, I am inclined to extend the surrender period of petitioner till 12.08.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that one of the co-accused has already been released on bail and the petitioner may be permitted to surrender in the Court below and move for bail and the claim of parity may be taken into account while adjudicating the bail application.

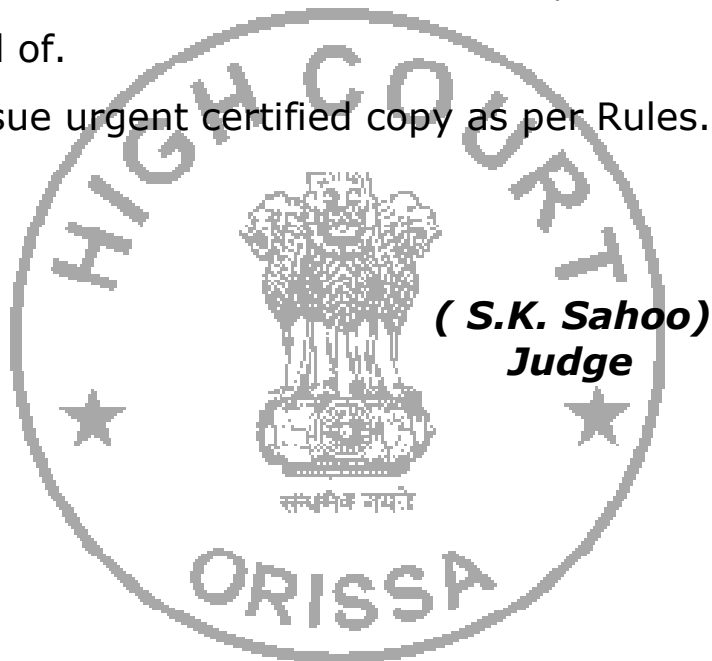
Learned counsel for the State has no serious objection.
