01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail, involving offences punishable under Sections 498-A/294/323/506, I.P.C. and Section 4 of the D.P. Act.
4. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of the offence, and the facts of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner. However, it is observed that, in the event the Petitioner surrender before the learned J.M.F.C., Khallikote in G.R. Case No.646 of 2022 corresponding to Khallikote P.S. Case No.278 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, the Petitioner shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper, after due verification of criminal antecedent against the Petitioner.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
