03. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
2. The Petitioner having been implicated in connection with Keonjhar Town P.S. Case No.167 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.636 of 2021 on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Keonjhar running for the alleged commission of offence under section-406/420/34 of the IPC running for the alleged commission of offence under section-302/34 of the IPC, have filed this application under section-438 of Cr.P.C. for her grant of anticipatory bail in the event of her arrest in the above mentioned case.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Counsel for the State as well as learned Counsel for the Informant.
4. Considering the submissions made and on going through the nature of accusations as those emanate from the materials on record; further keeping in view the other surrounding circumstances; I do not find it to be a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the Petitioner.
5. The ABLAPL is accordingly dismissed.
