1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant.
3. The petitioner is an accused in G.R. Case No.31 of 2022, pending on the files of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Kendrapara, arising out of Talchua Marine P.S. Case No.38 of 2022, under Sections 376(2) of IPC read with Section 4 of the POCSO Act and is in custody since 09.05.2022.
4. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Kendrapara, by order dated 26.05.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.
