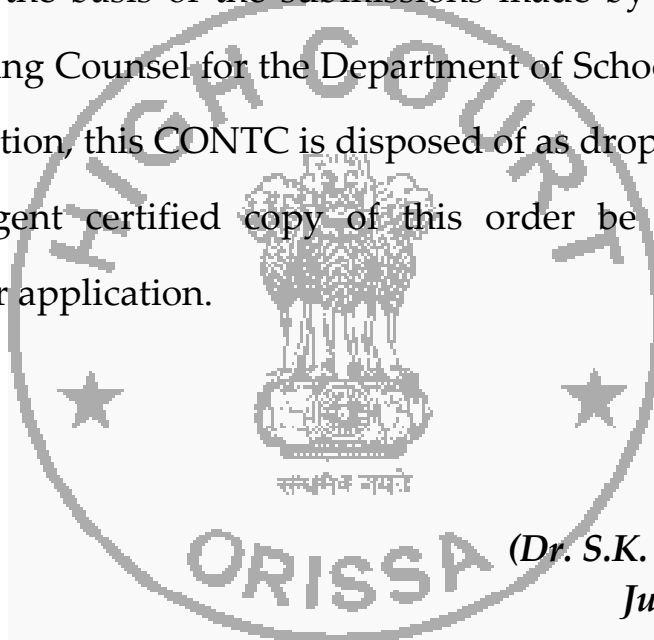
01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This CONTC has been filed by the Petitioners for non-compliance of the order dated 30.06.2021 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.18404 of 2021 directing the Opposite Party/ Contemnor to consider the representation filed by the Petitioners and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of authenticated/ certified copy of this order.
