1. Heard Mr. M. Chand, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. A.K. Nanda, learned Additional Government Advocate.

On oral prayer, Mr. Chand is permitted to implead the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Bhubaneswar as opposite party No.4 in this application in Court today.

2. According to Mr. Chand, the petitioner is aggrieved by the manner in which investigation is going on in connection with Air Field P.S. Case No.132 of 2022 registered for commission of offences under Sections 354/354-C/506/509 of I.P.C.

3. During course of hearing, Mr. Chand submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to move the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Bhubaneswar (opposite party No.4) for redressal of his grievances by filing a grievance petition and the said opposite party be directed to take a decision on such motion at an early date.

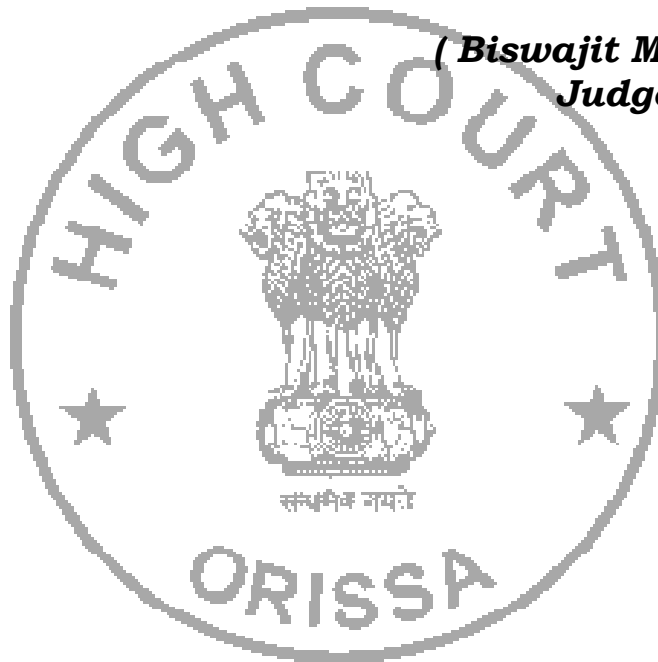
4. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court

grants liberty to the petitioner to file a grievance petition before opposite party No.4 through registered post within a period of two weeks from today. In the event, such a petition is filed along with a certified copy of this order, the opposite party No.4 is directed to take a decision on the same in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of such grievance petition and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, this CRLMP is disposed of.
