2. The petitioner is an accused in connection with Spl. Case No. 101 of 2021 corresponding to Singla P.S. Case No. 177 of 2020, pending on the file of the learned Special Judge, Balasore for the alleged commission of offence under Sections-363/366/376(2)(i)(n) of the IPC, read with Section-6 of POCSO Act.

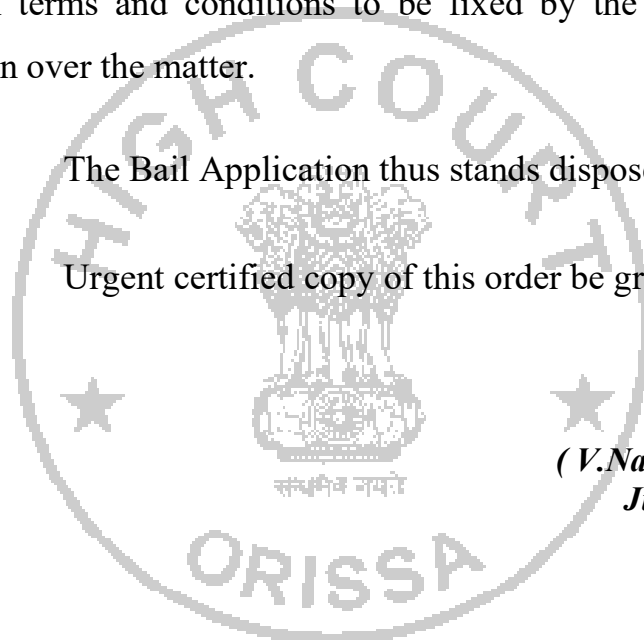
