01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. The petitioner seeking pre-arrest bail in connection C.T. Case No.606 of 2022, arising out of Khaira P.S. Case No.157 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Soro for commission of offence punishable under Sections 341/323/294/354-B/379/506/34 of I.P.C.
5. Considering the nature of allegations and gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, it is observed that, in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned J.M.F.C., Soro in C.T. Case No.606 of 2022 corresponding to Khaira P.S. Case No.157 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, the Petitioner shall be released on

bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper, after due verification of criminal antecedent against the Petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
