 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. This application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed by the Petitioner with a prayer to quash the criminal proceeding in 2(b)C.C. No.12 of 2011, arising out of Barbil Range O.R. Case No.196 BL of 2011-12, pending in the Court of J.M.F.C., Barbil.
 3. No one appears on behalf of the Petitioner when the matter is called. However, learned counsel for the State-Opposite Party is present.
 4. The case is of the year 2011.
 5. As such, this Court is of the view that the Petitioner is a recalcitrant litigant and does not want to proceed with the matter.
 6. Hence, this CRLMC stands dismissed for non-prosecution.

7. However, if the case is still pending and charge sheet in the aforesaid case has been filed, the Petitioner may seek quashment of the cognizance/charge, if framed, if so advised.

8. Interim order dated 10th April, 2012 passed by this Court in Misc. Case No.3264 of 2011 stands vacated.
