2. Heard Mr. A.K. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner.

3. The Petitioner has filed this Writ Petition seeking direction to the Opposite Parties to consider his representation/reply within a period of seven days keeping in mind the new academic session which is going to start after Summer Vacation.

4. Mr. A.K. Mishra, learned Counsel for the Petitioner contended that communication was made on 11.04.2022 through e-mail and the Petitioner is not well versed with the said system.
