02. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 341/323/294/307/427/506/34, I.P.C.
4. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of the offence and facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioners surrender before the learned S.D.J.M., Jajpur Road in connection with Jajpur Road P.S. Case No.318 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, the Petitioners shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of Injury Report. In the event it is found that

the injuries caused to the victim are grievous in nature, then this bail order shall automatically stand revoked.

Further, while imposing conditions for bail, learned Magistrate shall also impose the condition whereby the Petitioners shall not threaten, terrorise, ill-treat or harass the Informant and his family members or the prosecution witnesses in any manner whatsoever. Further, the Petitioners shall appear before the learned trial court on each date of trial, without fail.

Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of the bail of the Petitioners.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
