1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
 3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioners for anticipatory bail.
 4. The petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.520 of 2022, arising out of Balanga P.S. Case No.103 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Nimapara for commission of offence punishable under Sections 341/294/323/506/34, I.P.C.
 5. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that there was a land dispute with regard to demarcation. It is further alleged that while the informant putting the some sail over his land, the presence case arose between the parties and that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case.
 6. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the

fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioners surrender before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
