01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State. Perused the FIR as well as the statement of the petitioners.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioners for anticipatory bail.
4. The petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection C.T. Case No.251 of 2022, arising out of Raruan P.S. Case No.60 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Karanjia for commission of offence punishable under Sections 294/341/323/325/307/427/506/354/34 of I.P.C.
5. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the main accused Ajay Patra was assaulted and he has been taken into custody by the police. The present petitioner who are only the family members, having falsely implicated in the present case.

6. Considering the nature of allegations and gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. However, it is observed that, in the event the petitioners surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Karanjia in C.T. Case No.251 of 2022 corresponding to Raruan P.S. Case No. 60 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, the petitioners shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem fit and proper.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
