10. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.

The petitioner in this application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short “Cr.P.C.”) has prayed for quashing of the order dated 15.03.2017 passed by the learned J.M.F.C., Pattamundai in I.C.C. Case No.31 of 2017 taking cognizance of the offence under Section 138 of the N.I. Act.
