- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. The Petitioners have filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

*“The Petitioners, therefore, pray that your Lordships would be graciously pleased to admit this Writ Petition, call for the records and after hearing the parties allow the same, issue writ/writs in the nature of certiorari/mandamus and/or any other further writ/direction and set aside the order no. 2701/IV-63/2021 Estt dated 2.08.2021 & Letter no. 2703/2021 Estt dated 2.08.2021 passed by the BDO, Papadahandi/Opposite Party No.-5 under Annexure-1 series, and further be pleased to fix the pay of th petitioner in Level-8, Cell-24 at Rs.57,500/- in the Pay Matrix of ORSP Rules, 2017.*

*And for which the petitioner shall as in duty bound ever pray.”*

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that through highlighting their grievances, the petitioners have filed a

representation on 07.06.2022 at Annexure-9 to the Writ Petition before the Opp. Party No. 3, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, they pray that a direction be issued to the Opp. Party No. 3 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

4. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the Opposite Party No. 3 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law and taking into account Annexure-10 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

5. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
