01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. The petitioner seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.3493 of 2022 arising out of Nayapalli P.S. Case No.379 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar for commission of offence punishable under Sections 420/34, I.P.C.
5. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case.
6. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioner surrender before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a

period of three weeks from today, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
