1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody in connection with Koksara P.S. Case No.41 of 2022 corresponding to C.T. Case No.18 of 2022 of the Court of learned Dist. & Sessions Judge-cum- Special Court under POCSO Act, Bhawanipatna for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 363/341/342/376/511 of IPC read with Section 12 and 18 of POCSO Act.
4. It is alleged that the petitioner attempted to commit rape on the victim by forcibly taking her to a deserted farm house. However, because of timely intervention by the victim's father and other relations, he could not succeed.
5. Considering the nature of accusations, materials on record and in particular the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of Cr.PC., I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the

matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that he shall personally appear before the trial Court on each date of posting of the case without fail.
