- 2.** Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners.
- 3.** Learned counsel for the Contemnor/Opposite Party submits that the order dated 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 passed in W.P.(C) No.710 of 2019 has been duly complied with in as much as that after giving opportunity of hearing to the Petitioners, an order dated 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 was passed by the Collector, Bhadrak. The same was supplemented by another order dated 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 passed by Collector, Bhadrak, whereby the Gochar land over which the construction was made, was de-reserved being in excess of sanctioned reservation and thereby legalizing the construction made for the Revenue Department.
