1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
 2. During course of hearing, learned Counsel for the Petitioners does not want to press this bail application in respect of the Petitioner No.1. Accordingly, this application stands disposed of as not pressed in respect of Petitioner No.1. The ABLAPL is now confined only to Petitioner Nos. 2 to 6, hereinafter referred to as 'the Petitioners'.
 3. Heard learned Counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
 4. Considering the submissions and on going through the nature of accusations; further keeping in view the surrounding circumstances of the case as also concerning the Petitioners and in the absence of any other impediment, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender before the Court in seisin of the case in connection with Balanga P.S. Case No.57 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. Case No.405 of 2020 pending on the file of the learned J.M.F.C., Nimapara within three weeks hence and move for their

release on bail, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said Court.

5. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

Interim order passed on 14.08.2020 does no more survive in respect of Petitioner No.1.
