1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 13.06.2022 in connection with Hindol P.S. Case No.37 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.122 of 2022 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Hindol for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 376(2)(n)/294/506/417/341/34 of IPC.
4. Considering the submissions, materials on record and in particular the statement of the victim recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C., I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail.
